Speakers: Charles B. Lowrey, Ph.D.

Topic: Hazardous Waste Manifest – New Requirements

Dr. Lowrey graduated Cum Laude from Centenary College of Louisiana in 1963 with a BS in Chemistry and received his Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Chemistry from the University of Houston in 1968. He served as a professor of Chemistry at Centenary College from 1966 to 1977. In 1977 he joined Petroleum Associates of Lafayette as Manager of Research and Development and served with them until he joined Chemical Waste Management, Inc. in October 1979 as Sales and Administrative Manager of the Port Arthur, Texas facility. He continued with Chemical Waste Management through 1994, serving as Regional Technical Manager, Southern Region Sales Vice-President, and President - Southern Service Region. In January 1995, he was named the Industrial Market Manager for Waste Management of Southeast Texas. On January 1 of 1998 he assumed the duties of Director of Waste Management Industrial Services, Texas Division. Dr. Lowrey served as the Industrial Sales Manager for Texas after the merger of Waste Management and USA Waste Services in the third quarter of 1998. Since taking an early retirement option in December of 1998, Dr. Lowrey has served as a Special Waste Contractor with the Landfill Division of Waste Management of Texas, Inc.

Dr. Lowrey is a member of the American Chemical Society and served as the President of the Northwest Louisiana Section. He has co-authored several papers in drilling fluid rheology; and is co-inventor of a patent involving storage of radioactive waste.
